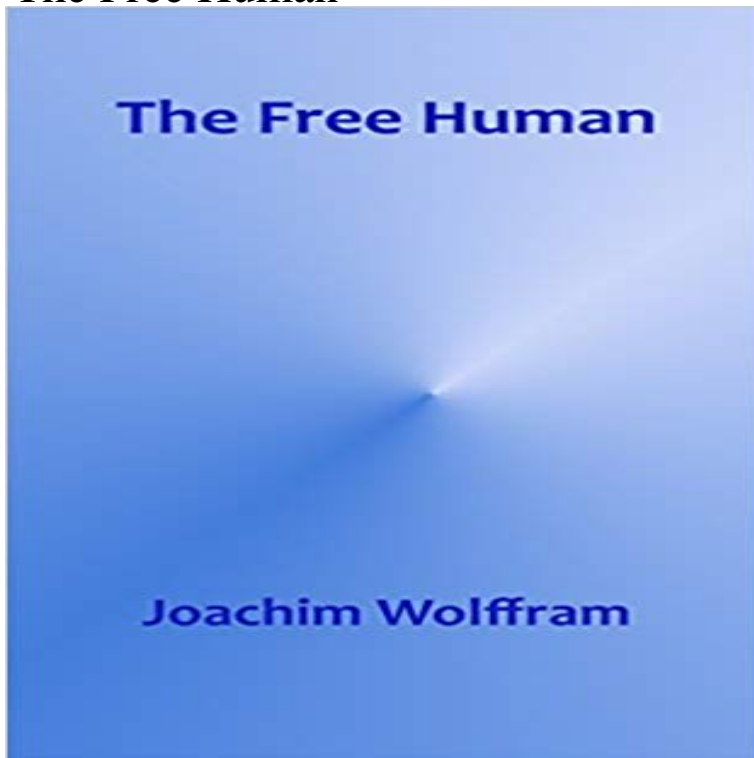


The Free Human
