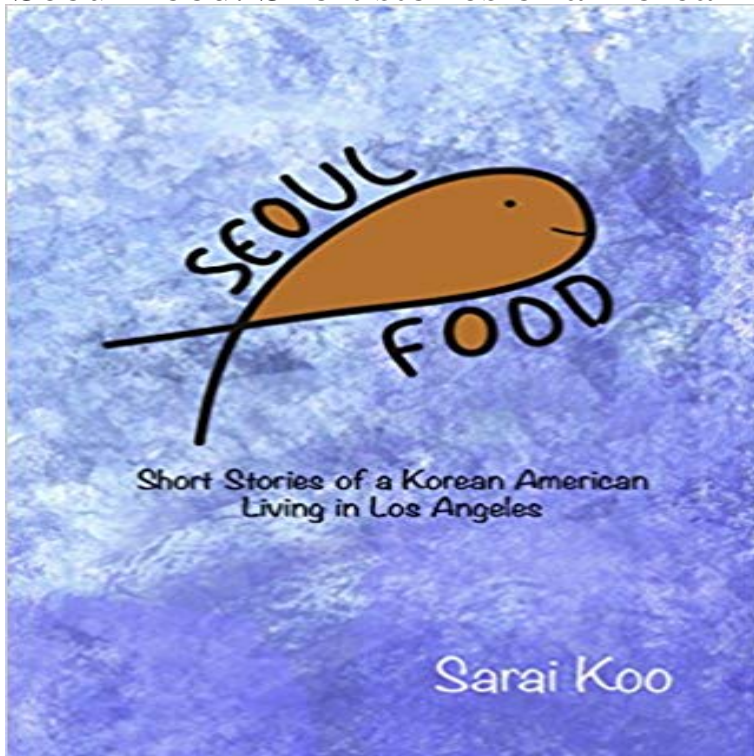


## Seoul Food: Short stories of a Korean American Living in Los Angeles
