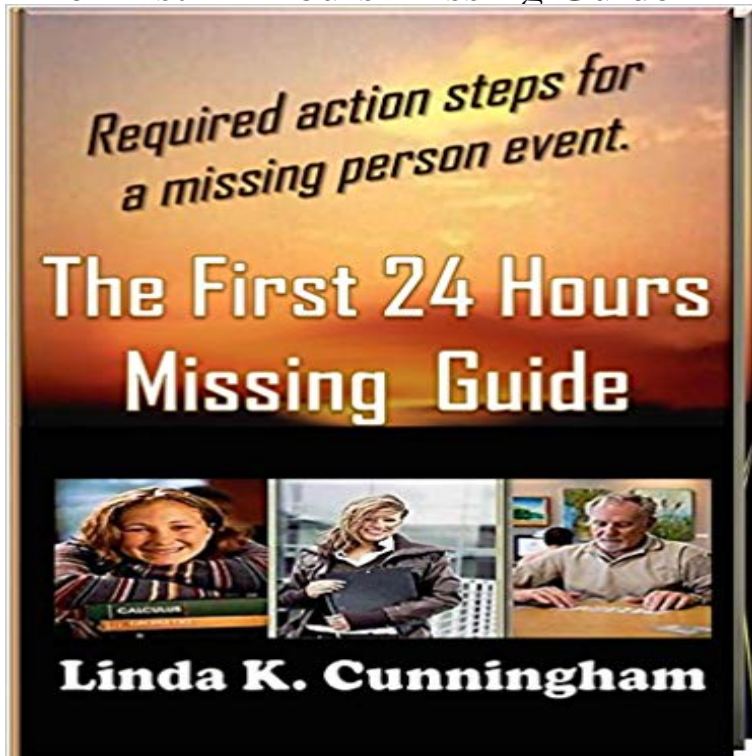


The First 24 Hours Missing Guide



You may know how to use email, but if a loved one goes missing, do you know what to do? The top priority required is time and knowledge of what must be done in a missing event. The 24 Guide provides the knowledge for the specific action steps required for notification contacts, necessary paperwork to complete, search details and most importantly; why it is necessary to check behind law enforcement to make sure paperwork, departmental notification steps like NCIC entry, DNA kit and medical examiner notification are done in the early stages of a missing person investigation. Many law enforcement are not trained for a missing person search and can delay or prevent search efforts. Examples that are known to delay investigations are required paperwork not completed properly, no case number, which is required to start an investigation, due to failure to file report to a National Data Bank for missing persons, improper agency coding or ignored the federal law (USA) requirement for filing and reporting a missing person under 18 report within two hours.
